

MODULAR DRAWER HEIGHTS

MODULAR DRAWERS

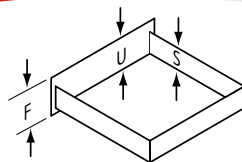
Modular cabinet housings and drawers are based on a total number of segments. The total numbers of the drawers must equal the segments of the cabinet.

When purchasing a new cabinet, determine the **USABLE HEIGHT** needed for the products you will be storing. This ensures you'll purchase a cabinet with drawers that have enough clearance around your product to allow the drawers to close easily.

For existing cabinets, measure your drawer based on the **FRONT HEIGHT** when you need to determine which drawer size you have for adding accessories or determining the usable height.
